ERION VOGLI


SPEAKER

Erion Vogli is a native Albanian believer who was saved under the ministry of missionary Jeff Bartell in the early 90s after the fall of communism in Albania.

Early on in his Christian walk, God put a desire in Erion's heart to study the Scriptures, to teach them to other believers, and to serve in various ministries at Tirana Bible Baptist Church. He moved to the United States to complete his college education and has served in church planting, Bible teaching, and training both in the States and in Albania.

God has given Erion and his wife, Jonida, a desire to take on a new ministry - to produce an accurate translation of the Bible in the Albanian language. They began the Albanian Bible Project in September 2021. Along with the translation of the Bible, they aim to produce a dictionary of the Bible, a website in Albanian with advanced search and study tools, and smartphone applications. They are currently close to finishing the New

After the fall of communism, a Bible translation was done in record time to produce a Bible that Albanian-speaking people could read since a complete Bible did not exist until then. Unfortunately, while that served as a good start, it also had many issues that would be visited later in a revision. The revision, done a few years later, introduced even more problems, and today there is still not an accurate translation of God's Word in Albanian.



MISSION

To provide an accurate translation of the Bible in the Albanian language, from the King James English Bible. This translation will be supported by Bible study tools such as Strong's Exhaustive Concordance, Bible dictionaries, etymological dictionaries, synonyms dictionaries, and a long list of books and supporting materials in manuscript evidence, translation resources,

VISION

To provide the Albanian church with an accurate translation of the Bible that anyone with the desire and the guidance of the Holy Spirit can read, study, and grow thereby.

LEE AND HEATHER CARTER

DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

After serving bi-vocationally in the Kansas City area for nearly 20 years, Lee joined the staff at Decatur Baptist Church to serve full time. While at Decatur Baptist, he had the opportunity to make several short-term mission journeys, many of which were to the Dominican Republic. After returning from the twelfth trip, God made it clear He was calling Lee and his family to the Dominican. In 2019 the Carters surrendered to serve full time in the DR, and in July of 2020 Lee, Heather, and their daughter, Bethany, moved to Santo Domingo. They currently live in the barrio of Valiente where they have established their first church, Primera Iglesia Bíblica en Valiente. They have seen hundreds receive Christ, many baptized, and many begin the process of discipleship.

LARRY AND JESSICA FRANKS

FIRST PRIORITY · ALABAMA

Larry and Jessica have two daughters, Chelsea and Hannah, one son-in-law, Kelby, and two grandkids, Mason and Lynlee. After 10 years of serving as youth and children's pastor at Decatur Baptist Church, in November of 2014, Larry became the full-time Executive Director of First Priority of Greater Decatur. His heart's passion is to see students come to know Christ and have a personal and thriving relationship with Him. First Priority started in 2009 on 18 campuses and has grown to currently serve 70 campuses in Morgan, Lawrence, and Cullman counties with the potential of reaching over 37,000 students with the gospel. The ministry of First Priority Greater Decatur has seen over 6,400 students make decisions for Christ on these public school campuses. In 2019, First Priority brought on the ministry called Clothe Our Kids. Clothe Our Kids works directly with school systems to clothe children in need. They recently surpassed the 8,000th student clothed through this ministry.

PROJECT PORTLAND · OREGON

Thomas surrendered his life to Christ at First Baptist Church New Philadelphia in 2008 and was discipled and trained there. Thomas' work in ministry began by teaching the Bible in a local jail and addiction recovery program. In 2017 the Hardings moved to Georgia to serve at Oakland Heights Baptist Church where Thomas most recently served as the discipleship pastor. In 2023 Thomas went on a church-planting survey trip to Portland, Oregon, where he saw the dark spiritual state of the city. Since then, Thomas has been taking regular trips to Portland to share the gospel – and there has been fruit! Thomas, Amber, and their three sons moved to Portland in 2024. They and their team are now in the beginning stages of planting a new church in the city.

FATMIR AND NELETA MACAJ

ALBANIA

In 1995 Fatmir started attending the Bible Baptist Church of Tirana, Albania, where he was discipled and began serving in ministry. In 2015 he was presented with the need to help in a new ministry for widows and orphans in Bathore, Albania. After prayer and God's leading, Fatmir knew that this would be the next field where he and his family would serve the Lord.

A large crowd gathered for their first meeting where the gospel was shared, and some were saved. They continued to have meetings for all different ages, and at the end of the year, the church was started. Fatmir has served as the pastor of Kisha Biblike Bathore since 2019.

ASIA

Jim and Cadie have served on the continent of Asia since 2002. In the early days they studied the language and culture through the language program, International Education and Exchange Association (IEEA). The function of the IEEA was to help the educational system of the area by placing qualified native English-speaking teachers in local schools, colleges and universities. Jim served as the regional director for the IEEA and he also assisted in Bible teaching and preaching. After 22 years serving the Lord in Asia, Jim and Cadie have permanently returned to the States. They have been instrumental in planting eight self-supporting churches along with discipling and ordaining four pastors who are currently leading these eight churches. They have also been working on translating the Bible into the language of the people in their area for the past several years.

REGGIE AND KIM REMPEL

HARVEST DEAF MINISTRIES · GEORGIA

Reggie and Kim joined Baptist International Missions, Inc, in 1983 and began serving as missionaries to the deaf. They began deaf ministries in local churches around the United States and later established a week-long summer camp in order to bring the different ministries together. Through the camp, many deaf young people began surrendering to serve in full-time ministry. At that time, there were no Bible colleges open for the deaf to attend and receive training, so Reggie felt the need to open a Bible college.

In 1994, Reggie and Kim sold their home and used the escrow funds to purchase a farm in Ringgold, Georgia. This spring they celebrated the 30th anniversary of the Harvest Deaf Bible College. The campus in Ringgold now houses a church for the deaf, the Bible College, and the deaf camp they began many years ago. Missionaries to the deaf trained through Harvest Deaf Bible College are serving all over the world in countries such as Nepal, Brazil, Cambodia, Dominican Republic, and others. Graduates have also planted churches for the deaf all over the United States.

ROM AND RACHEL RIBEIRO

BRAZIL

Rom and Rachel have been church planters in Brazil since 1993. They have established seven Bible-believing churches, a Bible institute, and a Christian school. Rom broadcasts over the radio two times daily, seven days a week. He graduated from Bob Jones University with a BA in Pastoral Studies/Business Administration and with an MS in Educational Leadership. Rachel was born into a missionary family and is a third-generation missionary. She graduated from Pensacola Christian College with a BS in Music Education. They have two daughters, Rochelle and Roxanne. Roxanne and her husband, Bruno, are missionaries on deputation preparing to return to Brazil as church planters as well.

In 2021 Freedom Baptist Church was established. They also plan to establish a Bible institute to train pastors and missionaries.
